CAMP USE RULES

IN CONSIDERATION OF GRANTING THIS PERMIT _____ AGREES TO FOLLOW THESE RULES:

1. **No Smoking is permitted in any camp facilities. Designated areas for smoking are available.**
2. Check in at the ranger's home when you arrive and when you are leaving.
3. Vehicles must stay in the parking area, not in the campsites. **No riders in the bed of trucks or on trailers.**
4. Alcohol, fireworks and firearms are not tolerated while on the Muskingum Valley Scout Reservation. Violation of this will mean immediate dismissal from the property. There will be no refund.
5. Trash should be bagged and put into the dumpsters or taken with you when you leave.
6. All fires must be attended at all times.
7. Standing timber will not be cut, unless permission is obtained from the ranger.
8. There must be at least two (2) adults present at all times. This is a BSA requirement. Groups not following this rule will be asked to leave the Reservation.
9. **There is no swimming or boating in the lake. You may fish on the shoreline, but we have a catch and release requirement.**
10. All major appliances within the kitchen are not available to be used and not available for rental use. Examples —walk in cooler/freezer, tilt skillet and dishwasher.
11. Please leave all wild animals alone. Mistreating wild animals will not be tolerated.
12. **IN CASE OF EMERGENCY—RANGER'S PHONE # (740) 829-2662.**
13. No sheath knives at camp.

We understand the above rules and agree to follow them. Any abuse of these rules may result in loss of privileges at the Reservation, and/or a loss for future use of this facility.
