

# MVSR Woodlands Program

MVSR has a 5-year program called the Woodlands program. Each year a Scout attends camp, if he/she chooses to be adventurous and take on some additional items they can earn a bead each year at camp! Once a Scout has completed 5 years of the Woodlands Program, he/she will have the full MVSR Totem that is made with our S.T.E.M. technology every year!!!

There are forms available in the Dining hall. Scouts should lead the adventure and grab this form, complete the journey, get a Scoutmaster signature, and turn back in by lunch on Friday to earn their respective years bead; first year Woodlands Scouts will also get the leather strap to wear on their uniform.

## 1<sup>st</sup> Year

(Turtle Totem)

Attend Camp for one whole week

Advance in rank, participate in the 1st year program (Netami), or earn a merit badge.

Identify 10 plants, 5 constellations, and 5 birds

Participate in a camp "Good Turn Project"

Attempt the BSA swim test

Demonstrate 'Scout Spirit' during your week in camp.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Year

(Badger Totem)

Attend Camp for a whole week

Be a Second Class Scout by the end of your week in camp  
(if you are already earn a merit badge in camp)

Identify 15 plants, 8 constellations and 8 insects

Participate in a camp "Good Turn Project"

Attempt the BSA swim test or swim 25 yards

Demonstrate 'Scout Spirit' during your week in camp.

## 3<sup>rd</sup> Year

(Bear Totem)

Attend Camp for the whole week

Be a First Class Scout by the end of your week in camp  
(if you are already earn a merit badge in camp)

Identify 20 plants, 10 constellations, and 15 mammals

Participate in a camp "Good Turn Project"

Attempt the BSA swim test or swim 50 yards

Demonstrate 'Scout Spirit' during your week in camp.

## 4<sup>th</sup> Year

(Wolf Totem)

Attend camp for the whole week

Be a star Rank Scout by the end of your week in camp  
(if you are already earn a merit badge in camp)

Hold and fulfill a leadership role in your troop

Participate in a camp "Good Turn Project"

Pass a BSA swim test by swimming 100 yards

Demonstrate 'Scout Spirit' during your week in camp

## 5<sup>th</sup> Year

(Eagle totem)

Attend camp for the whole week

Be a Life Rank Scout by the end of your week in camp  
(if you are already earn a merit badge in camp)

Hold and fulfill a Leadership role in your troop

Participate in a camp "Good Turn Project"

Mentor 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> years in fulfilling their camp honors requirements

Demonstrate 'Scout Spirit' during your week in camp.
